Parish Updates 2016/2017

The end of the fiscal year 2016/17 was June 30th. Financial Reports for 2016/17 for Saint John Vianney and St. Paschal need to be approved in October by the Board of Directors and sent to the Bishop by November 1, 2017. The chairman of the parish finance council, the pastor and dean (priest) from the east deanery make up the board of directors for each parish.

In June of 2017 St. Paschal and St. John Vianney began the 5th year as twinned Parishes with one Pastor for both Parishes. There have been many adjustments as both Communities have worked well together.

For St. John Vianney Parish the major source of income is contributions. As we celebrated Fr. Charlie Skok's 90th Birthday, 65th Anniversary of Priesthood, and 25 years of service at SJV, we invite everyone to support the St. John Vianney Foundation for the future of the Parish.

Saint John Vianney Catholic School relies on tuitions, parish subsidy, fund raisers and special donations including the monthly yellow envelope. The Marian Fuchs' Foundation seeks to support the School into the future.

St. Paschal, beyond regular donations, owns five rental homes near the church which help to support the parish. West Valley School District leases the St. Paschal school building. They have remodeled the building. The St. Paschal Educare uses part of the basement of the school. They are currently self sufficient.

Both Parishes support the needy through the monthly poverty envelope. It continues to be very challenging without additional school enrollment and more parish members at both Parishes to increase our income. Our Stewardship Committee is helping us to face the challenges ahead.
